Humboldt County Statistics

Last year Humboldt County has **lost 12 young residents** between the ages of **16 and 24** due to motor vehicle crashes.



In **2006** Humboldt County lost eight young residents between the ages of **16** and **24** due to motor vehicle crashes.

In a **5** year period in Humboldt County, **50 %** of local drivers between the ages of **16 and 20** were **NOT BUCKLED UP** at the time of the crash.



National Statistics

We lose about **40,000** people every year to motor vehicle crashes in the United States. That's about the size of the entire populations of Eureka and Arcata combined. We also lose about **5000 TEENAGERS EVERY YEAR.**

Almost **1/2** of fatal crashes involving teen drivers **occurred at night (between 9 PM and 6 AM)**

31 % of teen drivers killed in 2006 had been drinking, according to NHTSA. **25 %** had a blood alcohol concentration of **.08 or higher.**
